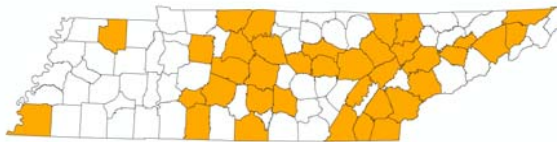

2008 Conference Attendee Distribution:

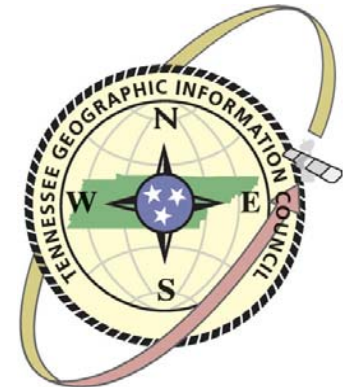
